They were indeed the first local band to establish a name regionally by conquering Hong Kong and had its own fan club there, plus weekly T.V. appearances, countless well received concerts and records grabbed by local teenagers when they

were released everytime.

Looking back, one wonders why local music diminishes as time slips by.

Yes, when we look back, there is only one band in our pop history who achieved that -THE QUESTS.

With Reggie's distinctive lead guitar, Jap's rousing rhythm, Henry's cool bass, Wee's thumping beat plus Vernon's soulful singing, together

they produced a most unmistakeable sound and their recordings are worth tracing.

I grew up with THE QUESTS' music, witnessed their power and influence towards our daily life, understood what a real talented multi-cultured band it was. They could record in English, Malay and Chinese and also played an important role in upgrading the local recording standard.

In reminiscence, it was a great pity that such great music had not been preserved. That was the reason that I pursuaded them to come back together to cut this special album. To them, it is an odyssey of their triumph and an audacious attempt to rediscover the best in their creativity.

Today, in putting our efforts together, it is a serious approach to THE QUESTS' legacy. It is an earnest in quest of THE QUESTS' music. The project is not merely nostalgia,

but it is a QUESTS' approach to their heyday music if they were still playing today. It is an honest reflection of THE QUESTS' power.

Emotionally, I believe it will bring tears to our eyes and unforgettable memories to our hearts, to realise how we had our heroes those days.

This is not just an ordinary recording. It is a chapter in our pop history and it is a piece of pop

treasure we should value and we certainly hope that this is not their swan song. Thank you Reggie, Jap. Henry, Wee and


