Desktop Device

- Any desktop computer with WiFi / data (e.g. 4G, 5G) connection.
- Desktop web browser

- Your year of birth (in YYYY format) as the PIN

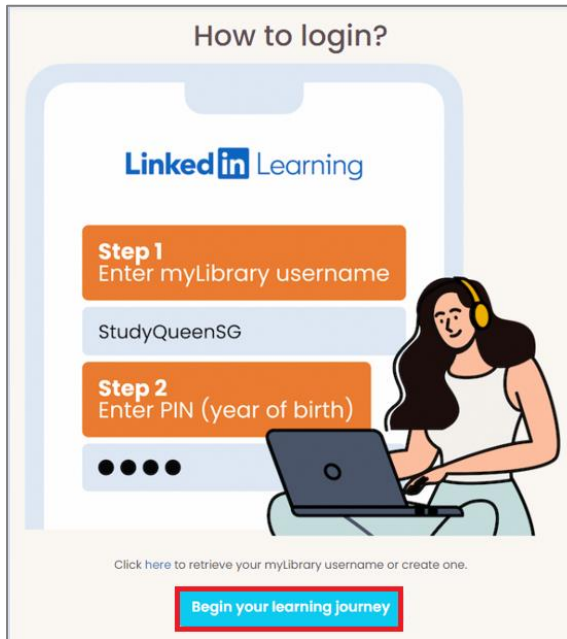

Access NLB's eResources website and login with your myLibrary username and password (go to <https://eresources.nlb.gov.sg/main/Browse?startsWith=L>). Click on "LinkedIn Learning".

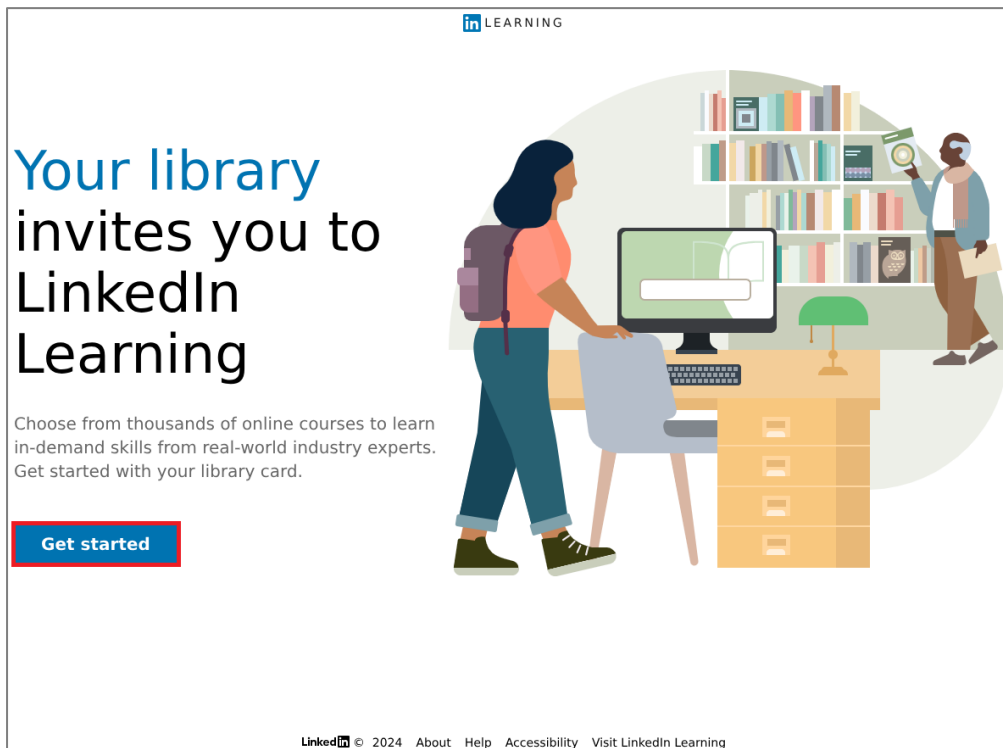
Step 2

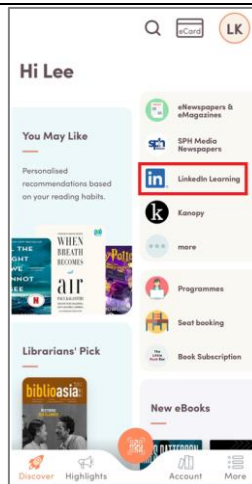

Install and launch the NLB Mobile app. Login with your myLibrary username and password where prompted. Tap on LinkedIn Learning.



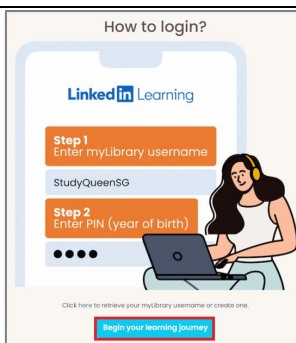

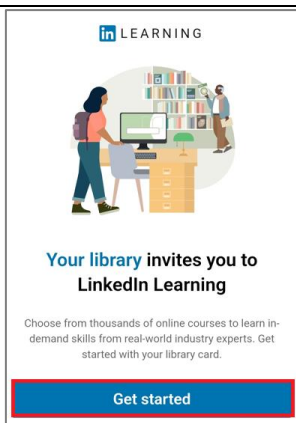

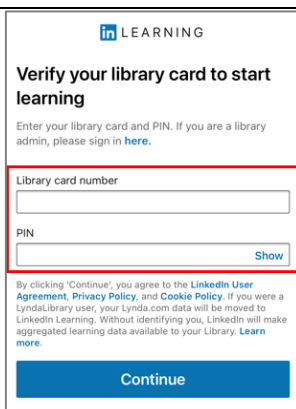
Click "Get started" to access "LinkedIn Learning".

Download and install the LinkedIn Learning app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store on your mobile device.




Step 2





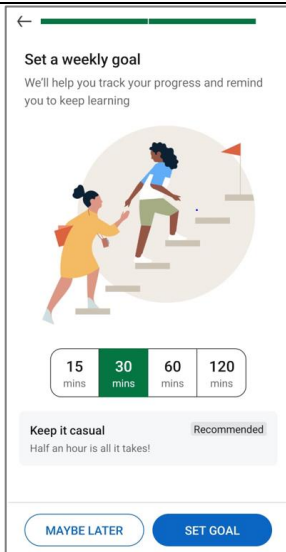
Step 7

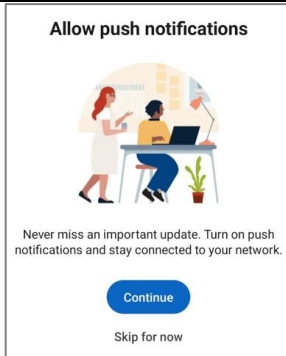

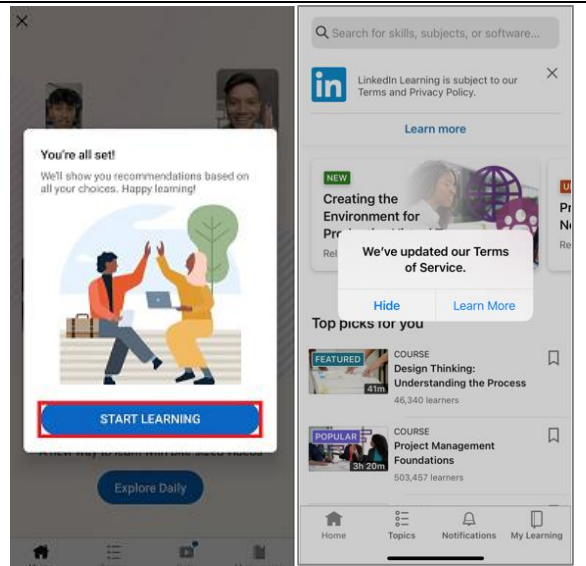
Step 9
