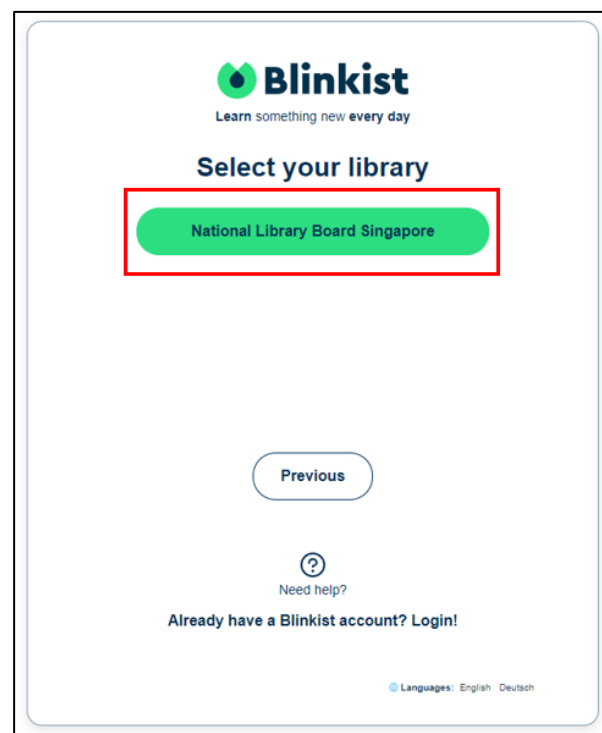

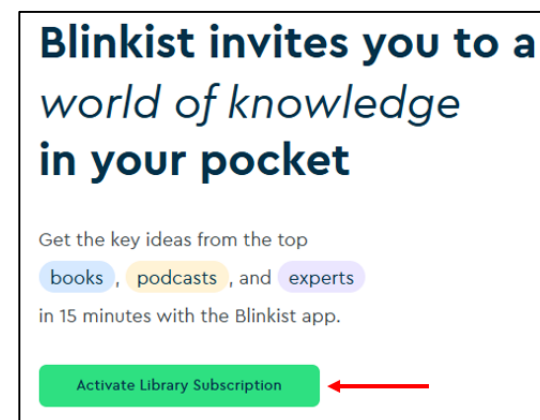

Step 4

Key in your email address and password to create your Blinkist account.

Note: The email address does not need to be the same as the email address registered in your myLibrary username account.

Alternatively, you may also use your Google/Apple account as the login credentials for your Blinkist account.

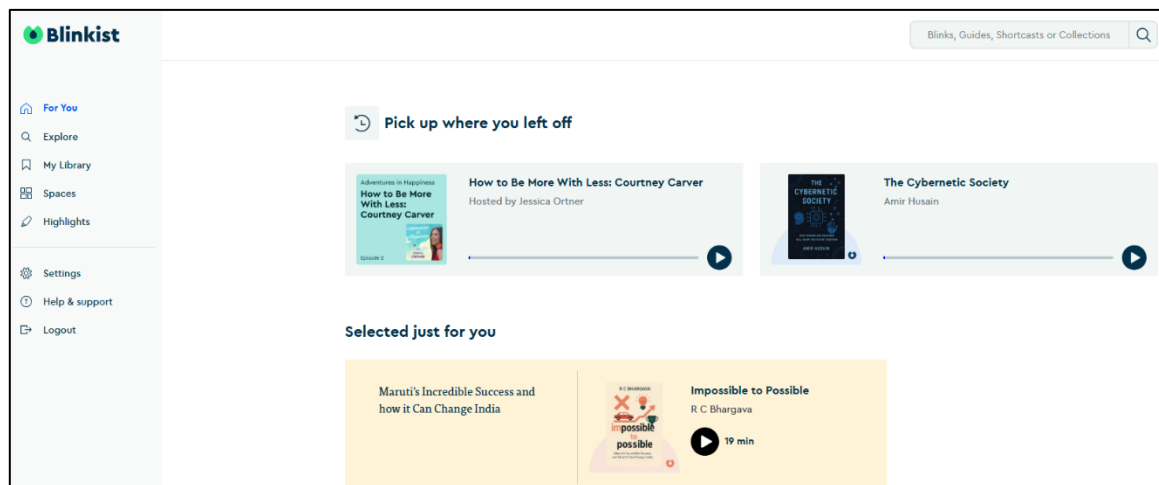

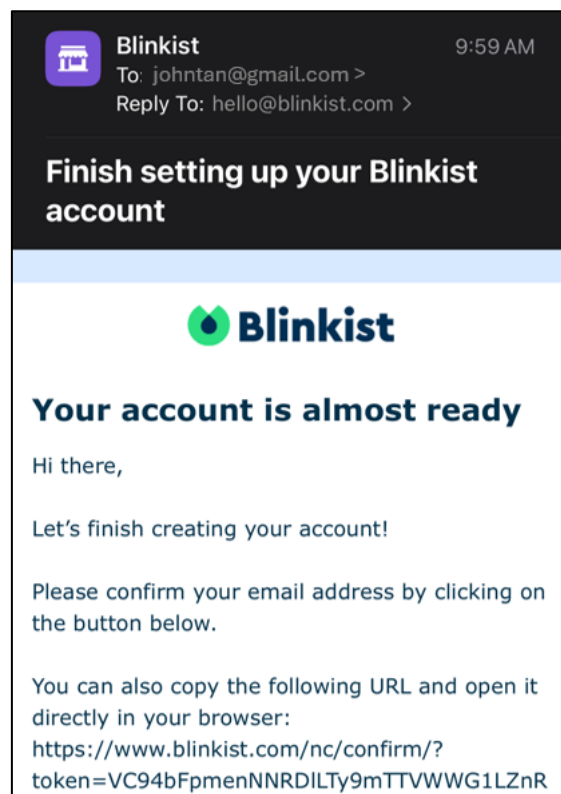

To access Blinkist, you will need your [NLB myLibrary username](#).

***Note:**

- Library members who are accessing Blinkist for the first time have to create a Blinkist account to access the content. Refer to Section A of this document for the step-by-step guide to set up the Blinkist account.
- A Blinkist account enables users to access Blinkist on the mobile app and its features such as downloading content for offline use, and personalisation e.g. highlighting content etc.

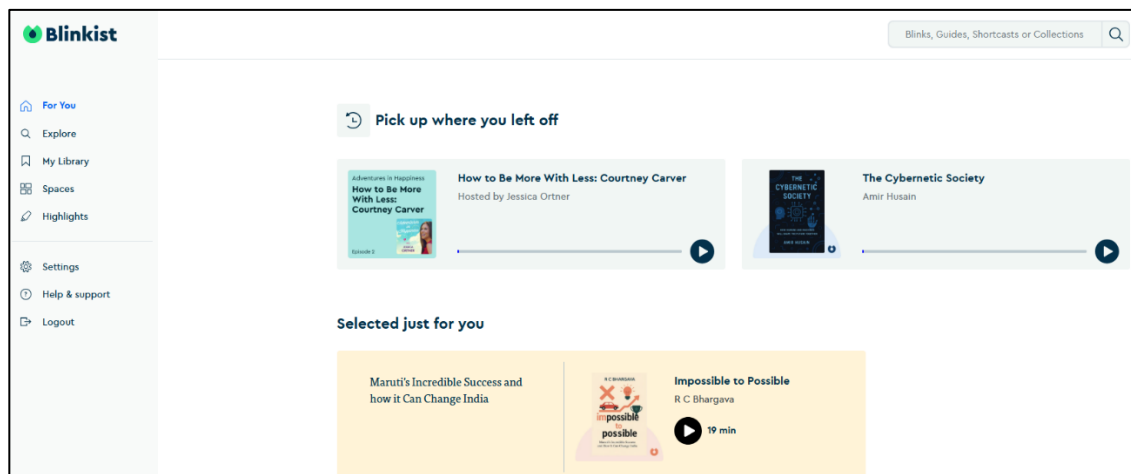

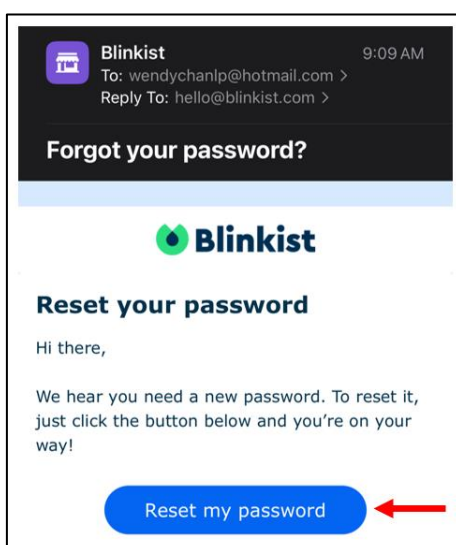


**Step 6**

Step 7


You will be redirected to Blinkist webpage to enter your new password.

- You will then be able to access Blinkist after logging in.



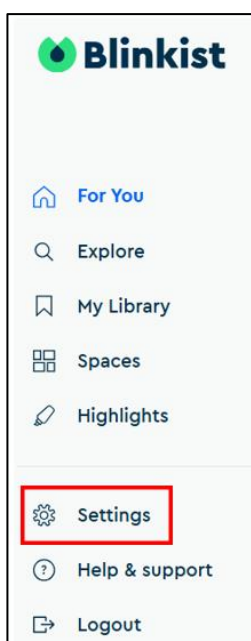


