Almost 20 years ago, in the first years of the Montreux Jazz Festival, I brought from the USA, the funkiest, jazziest small combo from the time, YOUNG-HOLT UNLIMITED. They had one big hit already "Wack-Wack." They were so great that I tried to get them back to Montreux every year but without success. I did not dream that ISAAC "REDD" HOLT and ELDEE YOUNG would be back in 1988 with JEREMY MONTEIRO!

In November 1987, while I was in Singapore with Jimmy Wee (WEA managing director) at the famous Saxophone Jazz Club, I met with Jeremy Monteiro who said, "Hey! I would love to play Montreux." I said, "Why not? Just get a swinging group together and I will give you a spot on the Marathon Night which will feature Chick Corea Akoustic Band, Crowded House, Salif Keita, Courtney Pine Quintet, Jean-Luc Ponty, Mongo Santamaria, Yellowjackets, Womack & Womack, Scarlet Rivera and a Swiss folk group."

I added that they should be able to play around midnight. But with surprises, delays, extended sets, I introduced them at ... 5.00 am! By that time, part of the audience expected the big traditional breakfast buffet and a break ...

Instead of that, JEREMY MONTEIRO introduced ISAAC "REDD" HOLT (drums), O'DONEL LEVY (guitar), JOHN STUBBLEFIELD (saxophones) and ELDEE YOUNG (bass) and the audience suddenly got up and started dancing. Everyone had a ball!

David Richards, the ace recording engineer of David Bowie, Queen, Chris Rea, among others, captured the spirit and the exciting atmosphere of the unforgettable set which will remain a classic concert of the first 22 years of Montreux.
