All sketches were entirely concocted by Siva Choy except “ The Tunnel” which was recorded ad lib, based on a storyline by Jay Shotam. Produced & engineered by Raymond Kelly.

## “ Why U so like Dat ? -The CD ”

This CD is made up of eleven tracks from the original album, with seven (7) new tracks featuring the voices of Mark Van Cylenburg, Jay Shotam, Richard Habib Khan, Nurwati bte Mohd Yassin, Aeha Sivamayam, Annie Seow & Siva Choy. “One Fine Summerra Morning” lyrics by Victor Savage, features S Rajagopal on vocals, Maniam on tablas & Ken Chua on the sitar. “ Hey, Gumok, Gumok” features Annie Tan on vocals & Siva Choy on the synthesizer. “The 5 C’s” composed by Farid Long features Siva Choy on vocals, Steven Rufus on tenor sax, John Chee on guitar, R Segar on bass, Coopusami Rave on piano & Richard Habib Khan on drums.

All sketches were entirely concocted by Siva Choy. “The Airline Reservation” an earlier sketch concocted by Siva Choy and Jay Shotam in 1976 on the album “Long Number Lah”, was re-recorded with Jay Shotam. All sketches were recorded and engineered at Polydox Studio. The new music tracks were recorded and engineered by John Herbert at Lion Studio.
