

Leonard Tan first started out in the local music industry as a DJ in 1989, and later went on to further pursue a career in music by forming Club Ecstasy. Founded in 1992, Club Ecstasy was Singapore's first electronic dance band, comprising 3 music producers and a vocalist.

Club Ecstasy won Singapore's Best Album Award in 1995 and was even invited to Bangkok, Thailand to perform a concert in the most famous club there. After releasing 3 successful albums (under the VMP International record label), Club E disbanded soon after. Leonard continued as a solo artiste called The Force, scoring 3 national radio Top 10 singles with "I Got What He Don't", "Lessons In Love" and "The 3 T's Jam."

Now just known as Leonard T, he has developed a totally new sound to establish his ultimate musical identity- funky, progressive house with a dark, vocal twist! His lyrics are melancholic and heart wrenching... but in an enchanting and mesmerising way!

Leonard is currently working in a record company as an A&R manager, and also writes part time for local music magazines. Aside from releasing his own artiste material, he produces commercial jingles for local TV programmes and remixes for other artistes.
